STIPENDS FOR UNSUCCESSFUL PHASE II OFFERORS:

- a. This solicitation uses the Two-Phase Design-Build selection procedures, as described in FAR Sub-Part 36.3, and provides for payment of a "stipend" to those unsuccessful Phase II offerors not selected for award of the resulting design-build contract.
- b. In order to promote increased competition and to enhance design innovation, the Government offers to pay a stipend of \$75,000 to an unsuccessful Phase II offeror, in consideration for preparation of a Phase II technical design proposal, as described herein.
- c. Acceptance of a stipend is voluntary. An otherwise eligible, unsuccessful Phase II offeror may decline acceptance of a stipend. In that event, the offeror will retain full rights to its Phase II proposal; and, the Government's rights described in this clause are inapplicable to that proposal.
- d. Upon acceptance of a stipend by the unsuccessful Phase II offeror, the Government may utilize any part of the offeror's resulting design for the contract resulting from this solicitation and in solicitations or contracts for other projects, whether they be for design-build or for traditional full design-bid-build construction, renovation, or maintenance repair projects. All provisions of the DFARS clause "Government Rights (Unlimited)" are applicable to the Government's rights to the design.
- e. To be eligible for a stipend, the unsuccessful offeror's technical design proposal must be essentially rated as "Acceptable" in all Phase II technical evaluation criteria areas and must be considered a "conforming proposal", essentially conforming to this solicitation's Government furnished design criteria. Some insignificant, minor deficiencies or weaknesses may be allowed, as long as the overall design proposal meets the requirements for "Acceptable".
