PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

1.2 WORK COVERED BY CONTRACT DOCUMENTS – PHASE 1, 2 & 3

A PHASE 1: The project phase shall include all the rough grading except the Parking Lot, all final grading except for the inside of the track, installation of a synthetic NCAA running track, new bleachers, athletic field events, a scoreboard, utility conduits, perimeter retaining wall and a portion of the fencing. The phase shall also include the installation of grass in Phase 3 regions south of the track. Rough grading elevation inside of the track shall meet the track elevation. The bleachers shall be in accordance with the contract documents and national and local codes.

B PHASE 2: The phase will consist of work within the track. Work includes tilling, compost base application, irrigation, final grading of football field, sprigging, surface and perimeter drainage of the interior field, inside of the track. This work will be furnished under a separate contract, and shall be performed concurrently with and in close coordination with Work of this Contract. The Corps of Engineers shall be responsible for coordinating the work of the Washington Redskins.

C PHASE 3: This phase includes the installation/construction of additional bleachers, the athletic storage facility, the press building and a locker room/concession building. The work includes all labor and materials necessary for complete buildings, including lighting, plumbing, HVAC, telecommunications and security systems, ready for occupancy. Other work includes gates, floodlights, parking lot, drinking fountains, and the remainder of the fencing.

1.3 CONTRACTS

A Project will be constructed under three (3) separate contracts in tandem with the Phases.

1.4 WORK SEQUENCE

A The work shall be conducted according to phases. Phase 1 shall start with the notice to proceed (NTP) and be completed within 120 calendar days. The other phases will be completed by a date to be specified by the Owner.

1.5 USE OF PREMISES

A General: The General Contractor shall have limited use of the site for construction operations, during the construction period. The contractor's use of premises is limited only by Owner's right to perform work or to retain other contractors for other unrelated work at the building.

1.6 EXISTING WORK

- A In addition to any FAR clauses pertaining to the protection of existing vegetation, structures, equipment, utilities, and improvements,
- B Remove or alter existing work in such a manner as to prevent injury or damage to any portions of the existing work which is to remain.
- C Repair or replace portions of existing work, which have been altered during construction operations to match existing or adjoining work, as approved by the Contracting Officer. At the completion of operations, existing work shall be in a condition equal to or better than that which existed before new work commenced.


